

<p><u>9<sup>th</sup> April – Psalm 14:1</u> The fool says in his heart, “There is no God.” They are corrupt, their deeds are vile; there is no one who does good. Truth: Rejecting God is foolish. Investigate: Why do people reject God? The Bible is clear – it’s not because of clever arguments. It’s not because there’s not enough evidence about God. It’s because we’re fools. We think we can be in charge. And that’s crazy! In v2 God looks down at us to see if we seek him. Sadly we don’t. But in the New Testament God not only looks down – he comes down to open our eyes to the truth.</p>	<p><u>10<sup>th</sup> April – Psalm 15:1-2</u> LORD, who may dwell in your sacred tent? Who may live on your holy mountain? The one whose walk is blameless, who does what is righteous, who speaks the truth from their heart... Truth: God’s people are to be just. Investigate: Read verses 2-5. What are God’s people to be like? Often we are not like this, but because of Jesus we can still ‘dwell on his holy mountain’. And more than that, by the Holy Spirit we can live more and more like this.</p>	<p><u>11<sup>th</sup> April – Psalm 16:4</u> Those who run after other gods will suffer more and more. I will not pour out libations of blood to such gods or take up their names on my lips. Truth: Those who follow other gods won’t win. And we shouldn’t follow them. Investigate: How might your friends ask you to do things that God says ‘don’t’? In David’s day people worshipped statues. Today people worship popularity and this can lead to bullying. We shouldn’t join in. Instead we can show them the God who gives us the path to life (v11).</p>
<p><u>12<sup>th</sup> April – Psalm 17:15</u> As for me, I will be vindicated and will see your face; when I awake, I will be satisfied with seeing your likeness. Truth: In God we have all we need. Investigate: What do you think you need to be happy? David knows that the only one he needs is God. People will have their treasure, but one day they will die and lose it all. But we will never lose God.</p>	<p><u>13<sup>th</sup> April – Psalm 18:6</u> In my distress I called to the LORD; I cried to my God for help. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came before him, into his ears. Truth: We can always call on God for help. Investigate: Who do you call when you’re scared or uncertain? It’s often our mum or dad. We may not understand what’s happening, but we know that they will keep us safe. It’s the same with God. When in trouble we can always turn to him and trust that he will keep us safe.</p>	<p><u>14<sup>th</sup> April – Psalm 19:1</u> The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of his hands. Truth: We see in creation that God exists and is glorious! Investigate: Look out of the window – what can you see that God has made? When you see a painting you know there was a painter. When you see a car you know there was a designer. When we see the beauty of the world we know there is a creator. The problem is that we need something more to know him personally...</p>
	<p><u>15<sup>th</sup> April – Psalm 19:7</u> The law of the LORD is perfect, refreshing the soul. The statutes of the LORD are trustworthy, making wise the simple. Truth: We know God through his word. Investigate: If you met someone new how would you find out who they are? You’d ask them! As you talk more you get to know each other better. That’s true with God. We can know something about him through his creation. But we can know him through his word.</p>
