

<p><u>30<sup>th</sup> April – Psalm 32:1</u> Blessed is the one whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.</p> <p>Truth: Jesus' death covers our sin – we're forgiven!</p> <p>Investigate: What wrong things have you done today? Don't be like a stubborn donkey – be honest with God – ask his forgiveness and he will answer.</p>	<p><u>1<sup>st</sup> May – Psalm 33:4</u> For the word of the LORD is right and true; he is faithful in all he does.</p> <p>Truth: God is good – he's totally trustworthy.</p> <p>Investigate: Who do you trust? Sometimes when things happen that we don't understand we can wonder if God really is good. But we can always trust him. He's always trustworthy and we know that because of what he's already done.</p>	<p><u>2<sup>nd</sup> May – Psalm 34:19-20</u> The righteous person may have many troubles, but the LORD delivers him from them all; he protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.</p> <p>Truth: Jesus was righteous – and his Father delivered him.</p> <p>Investigate: Read John 19:36. It was normal for the legs of someone being crucified to be broken. But they didn't do that to Jesus. He was the righteous man – and his Father delivered him.</p>
<p><u>3<sup>rd</sup> May – Psalm 35:10</u> My whole being will exclaim, "Who is like you, LORD? You rescue the poor from those too strong for them, the poor and needy from those who rob them."</p> <p>Truth: God defends the poor and needy.</p> <p>Investigate: What do you need to have a successful life. Often we think being rich means we are 'successful' – we can do what we want. But David knows God helps his people – those who are poor and needy. Where should you put your hope?</p>	<p><u>4<sup>th</sup> May – Psalm 36:2</u> In their own eyes they flatter themselves too much to detect or hate their sin.</p> <p>Truth: We cannot hide our sin.</p> <p>Investigate: When you've done something wrong do you try and hide it? This psalm says that we kid ourselves if we think we can hide our sin. Even if no-one on earth finds out, God knows. Read 1 John 1:8-9 and talk to God about your sin.</p>	<p><u>5<sup>th</sup> May – Psalm 37:7</u> Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him; do not fret when people succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes.</p> <p>Truth: Those who trust in God will win.</p> <p>Investigate: Do you ever look at those who don't follow God and think they seem to be having so much fun? It's tempting to worry that we've made the wrong choice following Jesus. But David says – wait patiently, God will come through for his people.</p>
	<p><u>6<sup>th</sup> May – Psalm 38:3</u> Because of your wrath there is no health in my body; there is no soundness in my bones because of my sin.</p> <p>Truth: Sin hurts.</p> <p>Investigate: What happens when you do wrong? Sometimes we end up hurt because of what we've done. Sometimes others are hurt. Sometimes the hurt is in the punishment we have – and that is to teach us that sin always hurts. It may not really hurt until we face God's judgement, or the pain was when Jesus faced that judgement on the cross. But sin always hurts. We need to turn to God in repentance.</p>
