| <p><u>7th May – John 1:12</u> Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God...</p> <p>Truth: If we trust Jesus we become children of God!</p> <p>Investigate: What do you think is wrong with the world? John says that the world is full of darkness – we don't like the truth. Because of that we're naturally enemies of God. But Jesus the light came to rescue us from that. To take us from enemies to children of God! And all we need to do is believe in his name – trust that he is the Word, God in the flesh.</p> | <p><u>8th May – John 1:46</u> "Come and see [Jesus]," said Philip.</p> <p>Truth: Take people to see Jesus.</p> <p>Investigate: How do you share the gospel? Although it's often scary, sharing the good news about Jesus (the gospel) is quite simple. Take people to Jesus. We found out yesterday that life is all about trusting in Jesus. So, take people to Jesus like Philip did. Tell them stories about him, show them what he's like and help them to see that he is the King.</p> | <p><u>9th May – John 2:11</u> What Jesus did here in Cana of Galilee was the first of the signs through which he revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him.</p> <p>Truth: The miracles Jesus did were signs of who he is to help us believe in him.</p> <p>Investigate: If someone said they were a king, what proof would you want? If someone said they were a professional footballer, what proof would you want? Jesus did miracles that were signs pointing to who he is. Watch out for the miracles throughout John and ask 'what does this tell us about Jesus?'</p> |
| <p><u>10th May – John 3:16</u> For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.</p> <p>Truth: God loved the world that had rejected him by sending his Son to die for that rebellion so we could have life.</p> <p>Investigate: Why did God rescue us? All too often we think it's because of us. Maybe he saw some potential in us. Actually, we had rejected him. We were his enemies. But in this way God loved the world - he sent his Son to die for his enemies.</p> | <p><u>11th May – John 4:14</u> "...whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life."</p> <p>Truth: Jesus is all we need.</p> <p>Investigate: What do you need for life to be good? The lady in the story thought she needed relationships to make life good. But after many boyfriends and husbands it wasn't working. Jesus told her that all she needed was to trust in him. He gives us everything we need so we'll never be 'thirsty' again – we won't need anything else.</p> | <p><u>12th May – John 4:29</u> "Come, see a man who told me everything I ever did. Could this be the Messiah?"</p> <p>Truth: Jesus is the King! Take people to see him.</p> <p>Investigate: The lady is amazed at what Jesus has just told her. So what does she do? She goes and tells everyone she knows about him! And she says – come and see him. Who can you invite to meet Jesus today?</p> |
